

What is an Online Mathematics Class? (And How It Works)

Online Mathematics classes are designed for students with strong background in mathematics and moderate knowledge of computer and internet who are self-motivated, self-disciplined, having strong commitment, can study independently, and are successful at keeping a study schedule for themselves. These classes are ideal for those students whom work schedule prevent them to enroll in regular classes.

All the course materials are to be learned independently by working on computer at **MyMathLab** web site. Students can use resources available on the web site to advance in the course. There is no need for any other supplemental materials such as videotapes, audiotapes, solution manual, or software for this course since all are provided at the publisher's web site. The book along with supplementary resources such as tutorials, solution guide, interactive animations, and audio and video clip can be accessed through www.MyMathLab.com.

These **Online** classes require *visits by the students to campus* during the semester for tests. Students who register for this class will complete their homework assignments online. Number of tests and format of the tests vary depending on the course. These tests can be taken at any of Lone Star College System campuses or satellites' Testing Centers.

Final Exam has to be taken only at Lone Star College-Montgomery Testing Center.
