



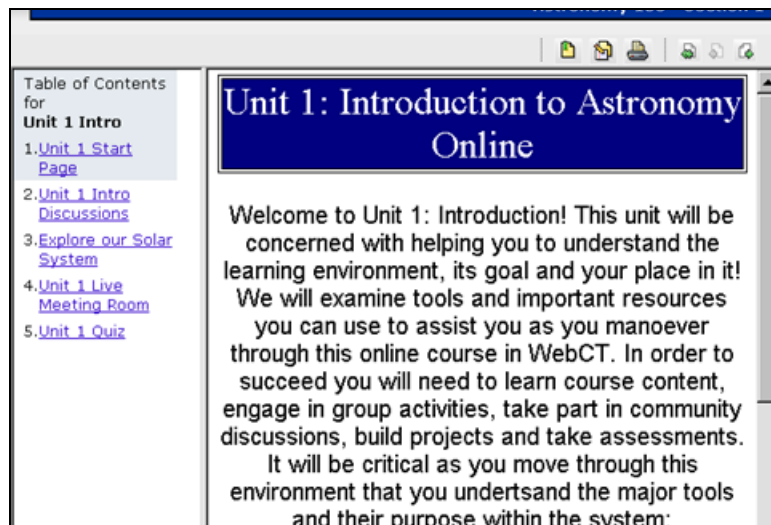
Introduction to the Learning Module

A learning module is a collection of content items and files, arranged sequentially and organized by a Table of Contents. It includes built-in navigation links and optional interactive tools.

Because of their linear nature, learning modules are sometimes compared to an online book or a chapter in a book, depending on how much information is presented. It's important, however, to remember that learning modules can bring together many different types of learning items and present them as a cohesive unit.

You can include the following types of items in a learning module:

- assessments
- assignments
- chat and whiteboard rooms
- content files
- discussion categories and topics
- media library collections
